

## Bruntsfield Links\*

A dance for four couples in a 4-couple longwise set 4x32 bar Reel

- 1 – 8      1st couple lead down the middle and back up to first place.  
9 – 16      1st and 2nd couples dance right hands across in a wheel, and left hands back, finishing in promenade hold facing the top (3s come in on the final step) for...  
17-24      1st, 2nd and 3rd couples dance a promenade.  
25-32      1st couple, followed by 2nd, 3rd and 4th couples, cast off to the bottom of the set. First couple make an arch, and the other couples dance under it and up to new positions.

Finish in the order 2,3,4,1, ready to start again.

Note: this dance may be danced 8 times through if preferred, giving each couple two turns at the top.

Devised for Sophia Marriage and Jonathan Pryce in honour of their wedding in St Martin of Tours Episcopal Church in Edinburgh on the 6<sup>th</sup> of July, 2002 and performed at the ensuing celebrations in The Hub. With much love and best wishes for the future.
